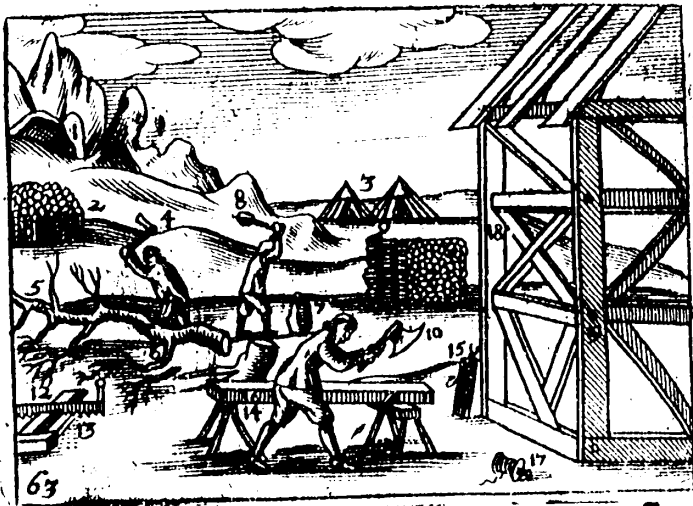


The Carpenter.

Afterwards he lifteth
 a beam upon tressels 14

 ramp-irons 16
 and marketh it out
 with a Line 17.

When he frameth
 the Walls 18 together,
 he fasteneth the great
 pieces with pins 19
